“ I was a poor student.

Not because I was incapable. Because school didn't know what to do with me. I was shy, often sick, alone in the hallways. Unhappy. I was asked to fit into a mould that wasn't mine. I eventually understood that it was up to me to adapt to the system — not the other way around.

But the traditional education system has deteriorated — a reality shared by 80% of parents. One in two students believes it does not prepare them for their future. They are right. The world has changed radically. The world our children will inhabit, even more so.

School has never evolved. Artificial intelligence, coding, the disruptions ahead — the traditional system has no answers.

We do.

That is why we created the Next Gen Program. Because your children deserve a school equal to the world they will live in.”

At Mouratoglou International School, we have transposed this culture of performance and individual development into education. Our conviction is simple: excellence is not a matter of chance — it rests on a methodology built around five fundamental pillars: listen, adapt, demand, prove and progress.

Supported by carefully selected teams, trusted by the families who place their confidence in us, this methodology now holds international accreditations and delivers outstanding success rates.



THE 5 PILLARS OF OUR METHODOLOGY

PILLAR 1 — LISTEN

UNDERSTAND THE STUDENT BEFORE TEACHING

At Mouratoglou International School, every teacher works like a coach: their role does not begin when they walk into the classroom — it begins before, by observing and seeking to understand who the student in front of them truly is.

We refuse the standardised model. Before teaching, we seek to understand. Every student arrives with their own profile. We take the time to analyse it: visual, auditory and experiential memory, concentration ability, relationship with pressure, self-confidence. This diagnosis precedes every educational plan.

Because a student who is understood is a student who progresses.

PILLAR 2 — ADAPT

BUILD TAILORED SUPPORT

It is not the student who must adapt to the system. It is the system that must adapt to the student.

With small class sizes (average of 15 students), we build truly individualised support. Teaching methods are adjusted, pace is modulated, motivational levers identified for each student — just as a training program is tailored to an athlete's physique, mindset and goals.

We personalise the approach to prevent disengagement, reduce unnecessary pressure and restore meaning to learning.

A student who learns according to their own way of working gains in efficiency, confidence and lasting engagement.

PILLAR 3 — DEMAND

PUSH TOWARDS EXCELLENCE WITHOUT SACRIFICING BALANCE

Rigour is part of our DNA. But never at the expense of wellbeing.

At the high school level in particular, the workload increases, exams multiply and the stakes become concrete. We support this rise in intensity while carefully preserving mental health and emotional stability.

HEAD OF THE AMERICAN SECTION

AN INTERNATIONAL VISION. A HUMAN DEMAND.

Born in Peru, raised in the United States, educated at leading American institutions, Ana Crovetto embodies the international DNA of Mouratoglou International School.

At age 4, she left Lima for New Jersey without speaking a word of English. She learned, adapted, progressed. Her journey then took her to Brazil, then to the American School of Lima, before completing her schooling in Arizona and enrolling at Arizona State University.

From an early age, she understood that education is a key. For her, the question was never **"Will you go to university?"** but: **"Which university?"**

"I don't want people to be afraid of me. I'm approachable."

RESILIENCE AS A DRIVING FORCE

At 16, faced with major family difficulties, she took on significant responsibilities while continuing to excel academically.

She joined the National Honor Society, earned an academic scholarship and pursued her university journey with determination.

HER CREDO

"There are no excuses when you have the will."

This resilience shaped her vision of education: demanding, structured, but profoundly human.

FROM TEACHER TO HEAD

After a Bachelor's degree, a Master's specialising in reading difficulties, and a Doctorate in school psychology, Ana built an international career in education — from California to Miami, by way of Arizona.

She supported students from sometimes very modest backgrounds, in environments where school is far more than a place of learning: a framework, an anchor, a chance.

In 2013, she joined Mouratoglou International School.

In 2018, she took over as Head of the American Section.

HER AMBITION?

To reveal the potential of Mouratoglou International School to the world.

During the international accreditation process, an evaluator told her:

"Your school is like a hidden diamond."

INTERVIEW WITH STÉPHANIE ANFOSSO

HEAD OF THE FRENCH SECTION

Why did you introduce the Dual Diploma at Mouratoglou International School?

Stéphanie Anfosso : I started thinking about it because more and more parents were asking us about alternatives to the French Baccalaureate. In the state sector, some schools already offered the International French Baccalaureate, and we were sensing growing demand from families. At the same time, we were also seeing that many students wanted to continue their studies abroad. The Dual Diploma quickly became an obvious choice: it is an exceptional opportunity that absolutely had to be offered at our school.

What does it change for students?

Stéphanie Anfosso : It opens an enormous number of doors. For a French student, obtaining both the Baccalaureate and an American diploma is a major asset — both for entering higher education and for building an international career. Today, we are the only independent private school on the French Riviera offering this double qualification.

Where does your international vision of education come from?

Stéphanie Anfosso : After my Baccalaureate, I studied in the United States. That gave me a different, more international vision of education. We follow the requirements of the French system here, but we wanted to add an extra dimension: more openness, more possibilities, more prospects for the future.

What sets your model apart from the state system?

Stéphanie Anfosso : There are several very concrete elements. First, educational continuity: our absenteeism rate is very low, classes are not cancelled, and teachers are highly committed. It is not that state school teachers are not competent — far from it. But when you have 35 or 40 students in a class, it becomes very difficult to offer personalised follow-up. Here, with smaller class sizes, support is more human, more effective and above all more personalised.



How do you incorporate innovation?

Stéphanie Anfosso : Yes, we are receptive to innovation, particularly artificial intelligence. But always with a reasoned approach. We raise students' awareness of responsible AI use: the objective is not to cheat or to replace their intellectual abilities, but to understand how to use it as a tool without becoming dependent on it.

After several years at Mouratoglou International School, what makes you most proud?

Stéphanie Anfosso : Since the school was founded, I have led the French section. And when I see a Year 13 student come back to see us after their Baccalaureate, the satisfaction is immense. I genuinely feel that I have contributed to something positive. We have helped students rebuild themselves, to regain confidence. Some were struggling in schools where they were more than 40 in a class.

They came here — it was sometimes difficult at first — but they succeeded. They passed their Baccalaureate and are now continuing in higher education. These are the moments when you realise our school is truly useful.

What is the spirit of Mouratoglou International School?

Stéphanie Anfosso : For me, it is the school I would have dreamed of for my own child. A school where we respect each student's pace and emotional balance, and where we build excellence without ever sacrificing mental health. Some institutions are too elitist, too rigid. Here, we pay very close attention to student wellbeing and fulfilment.

How do you recruit your teachers?

THE DUAL DIPLOMA

PROGRAM AVAILABLE FROM YEAR 10 (3ÈME)

THE DUAL DIPLOMA ALLOWS STUDENTS TO SIMULTANEOUSLY PREPARE THE FRENCH BACCALAUREATE (FOLLOWED IN PERSON) AND THE AMERICAN HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA (FOLLOWED REMOTELY), OFFERING AN INTERNATIONALLY RECOGNISED ACADEMIC PATHWAY.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Entry into the program is subject to an admission test in the form of a multiple-choice questionnaire (60 questions) assessing: grammar / vocabulary / reading comprehension

- / grammar
- / vocabulary
- / reading comprehension

PROGRAM STRUCTURE

Students follow their standard curriculum within the French section, complemented by the American program. They must validate 6 American credits:

- / 4 core subject credits
- / 2 elective credits of choice

The program represents approximately 3 to 5 hours of work per week. Each student must submit one piece of work per week per subject. Every three weeks, students take part in a live session:

- / a one-hour online class in a group of approximately 20 international students, led by an American teacher.
